2. Project events

Consortium wide events

The European Student Convention (ESC) was one of the main centrepieces of the INTEGRITY project and was held online on 8th & 9th September 2021. The convention brought together 150 students from 9 countries providing a unique opportunity to exchange experiences from different contexts about research integrity.

The "Diner Pensant – Tasteful conversations to empower good practices in science" was an online workshop held on 13th October which invited Academics & Researchers that supervise students and future researchers, as well as institutional board members and integrity professionals, to an entertaining and inspiring virtual dinner experience. They were invited to actively contribute with thoughts and experiences together with the fellow table guests by tasting some of the special offers on integrity issues.

On the 17th November, the H2020 INTEGRITY project partnered with the University of Porto and i3S to deliver an afternoon of talks aimed to present research integrity-related initiatives. The speakers with different backgrounds and experiences across Europe will present in this event findings with regards to integrity perception within the academic community, the promotion of research integrity and examples of some of the existing structures at the University of Porto and Europe for research integrity.

From the 18th to the 19th of November 2021, the Annual Meeting of the H2020 INTEGRITY Project took place at the Institute for Research and Innovation in Health, Porto (Portugal) on a hybrid session conducted by IBMC. The 11 European Consortium partners gathered to discuss and analyse of the achievements and final steps of work from the past twelve months. Interactive sessions for the workshops were conducted, where key discussions and sharing of ideas were made to refine the development of teaching tools and the next stages of the project.
