<b>Abstract</b>	<p>The paper discusses the levels of knowledge, understanding and importance of research integrity among students. Research integrity concerns standards and practices pertaining to citation and citation practices, including good citation practice, and avoiding plagiarism, collaborative work, and collaborative practice, including integrity in group work and when seeking help on individual assignments, and practices related to collecting, analyzing, and presenting data, including avoiding falsification and fabrication. One of the aspects presented is going to be the relationship between knowledge and training received in these areas and actually reported practices. Next, the relationship between the existence of clear rules and the recognition of grey areas will be discussed. Lastly, we will present the result of a large research study (as part of the 2020 project INTEGRITY) conducted in Denmark, Hungary, Ireland, Lithuania, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, and Switzerland and highlight the relevant differences among countries.</p>

<b>Abstract</b>	This H2020 funded program, started in Jan 2019, has as its core focus to develop educational tools in an evidence-based manner. To this purpose, a survey was developed to get more grip on the knowledge and needs students have on research integrity topics. The results of the survey were, next to literature reviews on RCR education, used to develop a teaching philosophy on RCR education (a so-called





competence profile), that takes 'empowerment' as a central focal point. In this presentation, I will describe what this core idea of empowerment entails and how the building blocks in the project have been used to build educational tools in a empowering and evidence-based manner.

## 2. Project events

### **Consortium wide events**

The European Student Convention (ESC) was one of the main centrepieces of the INTEGRITY project and was held online on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021. The convention brought together 150 students from 9 countries providing a unique opportunity to exchange experiences from different contexts about research integrity.

The “Diner Pensant – Tasteful conversations to empower good practices in science” was an online workshop held on 13<sup>th</sup> October which invited Academics & Researchers that supervise students and future researchers, as well as institutional board members and integrity professionals, to an entertaining and inspiring virtual dinner experience. They were invited to actively contribute with thoughts and experiences together with the fellow table guests by tasting some of the special offers on integrity issues.

On the 17<sup>th</sup> November, the H2020 INTEGRITY project partnered with the University of Porto and i3S to deliver an afternoon of talks aimed to present research integrity-related initiatives. The speakers with different backgrounds and experiences across Europe will present in this event findings with regards to integrity perception within the academic community, the promotion of research integrity and examples of some of the existing structures at the University of Porto and Europe for research integrity.

From the 18<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup> of November 2021, the Annual Meeting of the H2020 INTEGRITY Project took place at the Institute for Research and Innovation in Health, Porto (Portugal) on a hybrid session conducted by IBMC. The 11 European Consortium partners gathered to discuss and analyse of the achievements and final steps of work from the past twelve months. Interactive sessions for the workshops were conducted, where key discussions and sharing of ideas were made to refine the development of teaching tools and the next stages of the project.
