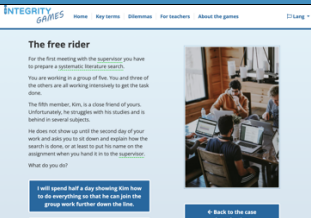


H2020 INTEGRITY Toolkit

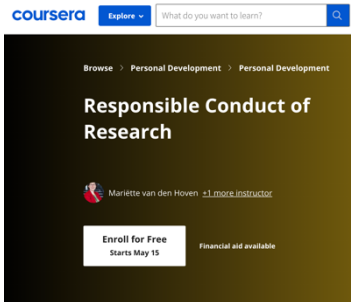
